Read the Passage Aloud: 1 Corinthians 13:11-13

Here are a few questions based on the Bible Study in worship this past Sunday

### 1. Grow Up - You Can't Stay on the Kiddie Rides

- What are some ways people demonstrate spiritual immaturity without realizing it?
- What is one "childish thing" (attitude, reaction, habit) you know God is asking you to grow past?
  - How can spiritual maturity help you face life's "impossible" missions?

Quote: "God won't give you the keys to the rollercoaster if you're still throwing tantrums in the stroller."

### 2. Look Up - Keep Your Eyes on the Ride Operator

- Paul says we "see only a reflection." How does that describe our spiritual understanding today?
  - Share a time when you couldn't see what God was doing, but later it all made sense.
  - How can you better train yourself to trust God when life feels unpredictable?

Quote: "You're not the one driving this ride—so quit grabbing the steering bar that doesn't exist."

### Buckle Up - Love Is the Safety Bar

- Why is love considered greater than faith or hope in this passage?
  - How can love serve as the anchor when your life feels chaotic?
  - Who in your life needs a bold act of love from you this week?

Quote: "Faith gets you on the ride, hope keeps you buckled in, but love makes the ride worth it."

### Reflection:

- What does this passage teach you about the kind of believer God wants you to become?
  - Where in your spiritual life are you coasting—and where do you need to step up?

## 7-DAY JOURNALING CHALLENGE

EACH DAY, READ THE ASSIGNED VERSE AND WRITE HONESTLY  
IN YOUR JOURNAL. USE THE PROMPTS TO REFLECT AND  
RESPOND.

### Day 1 – Growing Up

1 Corinthians 13:11

Prompt: What does “putting away childish things” look like in your life right now?

Identify one area where you need to grow in maturity.

### Day 2 – What’s Blocking My Growth?

Hebrews 5:12-14

Prompt: Are there habits or distractions that are keeping you in spiritual infancy?

What will it take to move forward?

### Day 3 – Trusting What I Can’t See

2 Corinthians 5:7

Prompt: Where is God asking you to walk by faith?

Write about an area where you need to trust even when you don’t understand.

### Day 5 – Living with Hope

Romans 15:13

Prompt: How’s your hope level?

What are you hoping for—and what are you hoping in?

### Day 4 – The Foggy Mirror

1 Corinthians 13:12

Prompt: What is something in your life you only understand “in part”?

How can you find peace without having all the answers?

### Day 6 – Leading with Love

John 13:34-35

Prompt: Who in your life is difficult to love right now?

What can you do to love like Jesus this week?

### Day 7 – The Greatest of These

1 Corinthians 13:13

Prompt: Love outlasts everything.

In the grand story God is writing, how is your love shaping your legacy?
