I Can't Believe You Did That

Mission Impossible Possible – Conclusion of Series

Ephesians 2:10

"For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."

7.13.25

Today we concluded the Mission Impossible Possible series...it has been fun and hopefully been helpful in stretching you just a bit into seeing your role on an Impossible Mission Force. Here is a review of the week with some additional thoughts that Pastor Jeff did not include in the Bible Study you heard.

You were handcrafted by God for a specific purpose.
When you live out that purpose, the world will look at your life and say, "I can't believe you did that!"
But deep down, you'll know... it was all Him.

Point 1: You Were Designed for This

Key Truths:

- The Greek word poiēma means "work of art" or "masterpiece."
- You are not a random product of chance. You were carefully crafted with specific gifts, skills, and opportunities to do things only you can do.
 - You're not waiting for purpose—you were born (again) into it.

Dig Deeper:

- Think of God's handiwork like a custom-made tool. It's not only beautiful—it's useful.
- You are not saved by your good works (Eph. 2:8-9), but you are saved for good works.
 - What makes you unique?
 - What gifts or passions might be part of God's design for you?

Point 2: God Gets the Glory – But You Get the Story

Key Truths:

- Every good work you do is evidence of what God is doing in you.
 - You are the living, breathing display of what God's grace can accomplish.
- When people are shocked by what you've done, you get to point back to the One who made it possible.

Dig Deeper:

- The phrase "prepared in advance" means pre-mapped—like missions waiting on your "yes."
 - Your story doesn't highlight your greatness. It spotlights God's faithfulness.
 - When has someone seen something in you and been amazed?
 - What's your story of "I can't believe God did that through me"?

EACH DAY, READ EPHESIANS 2:10 SLOWLY AND PRAYERFULLY.
LET IT SOAK IN, THEN JOURNAL YOUR RESPONSES.

Day 1: Who Am I Really?

- What does it mean to you that you are God's handiwork?
- How does seeing yourself as a "work of art" change how you view your identity?

Day 2: What's in My Toolbelt?

- What skills, talents, or passions has God given you?
- How might He want to use them in ways that seem "impossible" to you?

Day 3: What Was Prepared for Me?

- Think back over your life. Where can you see God "preparing" moments for you?
- What open doors might He be placing in front of you right now?

Day 4: Why Me, God?

- Have you ever felt too broken or unworthy for God to use?
- How does knowing you are created in Christ Jesus give you confidence to move forward?

Day 5: What Do I Want People to Say?

- If someone said "I can't believe you did that!" what would you hope they were talking about?
- What would you want people to know about God from watching your life?

Day 6: What's One "Good Work" Today?

- Ask God: "What's one good work you've prepared for me to do today?"
 - Then go do it.Afterward, journal what happened and how you felt.

Day 7: What's My Story?

- If someone asked you, "What has God done in your life that seemed impossible?"—what would you say?
- Write out your testimony in 5 sentences. Keep it handy. You never know when your story will change someone else's.

Your Mission: Should You Choose to Accept It...
Walk confidently in the purpose God designed you for.

Live so boldly in His mission that people around you say,
"I can't believe you did that!" ...and you get to smile and say, "Neither can I. But I know Who did."
