Are you Umbrella-ievably excited about living for God?
This is a week long study guide designed for you to do a deeper dive
into what we are doing in Celebration Worship
Grab a Bible, a pen, a journal, and find a time each day to spend a
few minutes reconnecting to what we are doing on Sunday morning

In this passage, we encounter a Roman centurion whose faith in Jesus is profound.
Despite his status and authority, the centurion recognizes the greater authority that Jesus holds. His
humility and understanding of authority lead to the miraculous healing of his servant. This story teaches
us about living under the authority of Christ and the freedom that comes from our identity in Him.

Day 1: Understanding Authority

Scripture Reading: Luke 7:1-3

Reflection:

The centurion recognized Jesus' authority and believed that His words alone could heal. Reflect on what it means to recognize Jesus' authority in your life.

Journal Questions:

1. What areas of your life do you struggle to submit to Jesus' authority?
2. How does acknowledging Jesus as the ultimate authority change your perspective on your circumstances?

Day 2: The Power of Faith

Scripture Reading: Luke 7:4-5

Reflection:

The centurion's faith was evident in how he spoke of Jesus to the Jewish elders. His faith was rooted in understanding and belief.

Journal Questions:

1. How does your faith influence your interactions with others?
2. Can you identify moments when your faith has encouraged someone else? Write about those experiences.

Day 3: Humility Before God

Scripture Reading: Luke 7:6-8

Reflection:

The centurion displayed humility by not feeling worthy to have Jesus come to his home.
This humility is a crucial aspect of our relationship with God.

Journal Questions:

1. In what ways do you express humility in your relationship with God?
2. How can embracing humility lead to greater freedom in your life?

Day 4: The Response of Jesus

Scripture Reading: Luke 7:9-10

Reflection:

Jesus marveled at the centurion's faith and responded with compassion.

This shows that faith is recognized and rewarded (think blessed!) by Jesus.

Journal Questions:

1. How does knowing that your faith can elicit a response from Jesus affect your daily life?
2. Reflect on a time when you felt Jesus respond to your faith. What did that experience teach you?

Day 5: Living Under Authority

Scripture Reading: Ephesians 1:20-22

Reflection:

In this passage, we learn about the authority of Christ over all things.

When we live under His authority, we are empowered to live freely.

Journal Questions:

1. What does it mean for you personally to live under the authority of Jesus?
2. How can you practically submit your life to His authority this week?

Day 6: Freedom in Christ

Scripture Reading: Galatians 5:1

Reflection:

Christ has set us free.

Understanding our identity in Him allows us to experience genuine freedom.

Journal Questions:

1. What does freedom in Christ look like in your life?
2. Are there any areas where you feel bound? How can you seek Jesus' authority to find freedom?

Day 7: Prayer and Commitment

Reflection:

Take time to pray and ask God to help you live under His authority and embrace your identity in Christ.

Journal Questions:

1. Write a prayer committing to live under Jesus' authority. Be creative, be honest, be expressive – this is a letter to Jesus
2. What specific steps will you take this week to deepen your understanding of your identity in Christ?

Wrap it all up

As you reflect on the centurion's faith, may you find courage to live under the authority of Jesus and experience the freedom that comes from your identity in Him.

Let this guide lead you into a deeper relationship with Christ, rooted in faith, humility, and the understanding of His power and love.
