#### Key Points From the Bible Study for Your Review

1. The Umbrella of Hope:

Hope is a confident expectation of good. It acts as a protective covering that helps us endure life's storms. Biblical Insight: Hope anchors our souls, providing stability amidst uncertainty (Hebrews 6:19).

#### 2. The Umbrella of Inheritance:

As believers, we inherit spiritual riches and blessings from God, which empower us to live victoriously. Biblical Insight: We are co-heirs with Christ (Romans 8:17), meaning the riches of His grace and promises are available to us.

#### 3. The Umbrella of Power:

God's power is not just a concept; it is a tangible force that we can access through faith, enabling us to overcome challenges.

Biblical Insight: The same power that raised Christ from the dead is at work in us (Ephesians 1:20-21).

How can you begin to claim it in your daily life?

Day 3: Tapping into Divine Power

Think about a persistent struggle in your life. How can you invite God's power into this situation?

Reflect on a time when you felt empowered by your faith. What did that look like, and how can you replicate it? Day 4: Dancing in the Rain How can you shift your perspective to see challenges as opportunities for growth?

Write about a "storm" you're currently experiencing. What steps can you take to embrace hope during this time?

Day 6: Building with God's Power Identify an area in your life where you feel you are trying to do things on your own. What would it look like to invite God into that process?

Reflect on a time when you saw God's power work through you. How did it change your circumstances? Day 5: The Buffet of Blessings Consider the blessings that God has provided in your life. Which ones do you often take for granted? (Be extremely honest – this is between you and God )

List three specific ways you can actively appreciate your spiritual inheritance this week.

#### Day 7: Sharing Your Umbrella

Think about someone in your life who may be struggling. How can you share the umbrellas of hope, inheritance, and power with them?

Write a letter or a note to this person, encouraging them and sharing the insights you've gained from this week's study.
