Daring to Trust God (Completely)

This study guide is designed to help you reflect on the message from our sermon, "Rev the Engine of Faith," and to deepen your understanding of trusting God completely. Each day offers a journaling question to guide your quiet time and encourage personal growth in faith. Grab your Bible, get out your journal, set aside a time each day to ponder the passages and then do a deeper dive into the what it means to take a leap of faith.

Ready ? Let's rev the engines!

Day 1: Listening to God's Call

Scripture: Genesis 12:1

Question: What is God asking you to leave behind in order to follow Him more fully?

Reflect on any fears or hesitations you may have about taking that leap.

Jot those down

Why do they cause fear for you?

Pray and ask God to turn the fear into a leap of faith

Day 2: The Nature of Faith

Scripture: * Hebrews 11:1

Question: How do you define faith in your life? In what ways does your understanding of faith align with or differ from the biblical definition?

If you define it differently...what will it take to get your definition to line up with God's definition?

Ask God to help you define faith correctly

Day 3: Embracing the Unknown

Scripture: Genesis 12:4

Question: Think about a time when you took a leap of faith without knowing the outcome. What did you learn from that experience, and how did it affect your trust in God?

FAITH

Day 4: The Risk of Faith

Scripture: Genesis 12:2-3

Question: Are there areas in your life where you feel God is calling you to take a risk for Him?

What opportunities might arise from stepping out in faith, even if it seems crazy to the world?

Jot down and pray about some ideas that you have as to how to make that happen

Day 5: Recognizing God's Promises

Scripture: Genesis 12:7

Question: Reflect on the promises God has made to you in Scripture.

Which promise gives you the most comfort and hope?

How can you hold onto that promise this week?

Day 6: Building Altars of Worship

Scripture: Genesis 12:8

Question: What practices can you incorporate into your life to remind you of God's faithfulness?

Consider creating "altars" of worship in your daily routine—how can you honor God amidst your journey?

Day 7: Moving Forward with Faith

Scripture: Genesis 12:9

Question: What steps can you take this week to act on the faith you've been contemplating?

Write down one specific action you can take to trust God more fully in your daily life.

Rev it up and wrap it up

As you complete this seven-day journaling journey, take time to pray and reflect on how God is working in your life. Trusting Him completely may require you to rev the engine of your faith, but remember: a great adventure awaits those who dare to leap! Feel free to revisit these questions whenever you need guidance or encouragement in your walk of faith.

And now get ready – this week is over but a new one is about to begin. Sunday morning we continue to explore The Leap!
